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St. Michael's in the Hills Episcopal Church in Toledo has received a 2026 United Thank Offering grant to support Neighbor to Neighbor Toledo: A Peace Initiative, a project focused on addressing division through kindness, connection, and loving one's neighbor.

Neighbor to Neighbor, also known as N2N, will partner with Mom's House of Toledo to create a new kindness program focused on children and youth. The project will address intergenerational and socioeconomic divides while empowering and investing in young leaders.
